

Halfway to Heaven Mustang Rescue Visitors Hold Harmless Agreement

Thank you for visiting Halfway to Heaven Mustang Rescue (“HTH”).

I understand that being around horses involves numerous inherent risks of injury that are my responsibility, and I assume these risks. I further understand that an animal, regardless of its training and usual past behavior and characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based on instinct or fear, which is a risk to be assumed by each participant in equine-related activities. I further understand that the inherent risks of equine activity mean those dangers or conditions which include, but are not limited to:

- The propensity of horses to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them.
- The unpredictability of a horse’s reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals.
- Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions.
- Collisions with other horses or objects.
- The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability.

I hereby release HTH, its owners, officers, agents, employees, and/or trainers from liability due to their negligence and/or gross negligence, and except to the extent of HTH’s willful and intentional misconduct, I shall bring no claims, demands, actions, and causes of action, and/or litigation, against HTH or any of its owners, agents, employees or trainers for any economic and/or non-economic losses due to bodily injury, death, and/or property damage sustained by me and/or my minor child or legal ward, or my personal horse in relation to the premises and operations of HTH,

including while riding, handling, or otherwise being near horses owned by or in the care, custody and control of HTH.

WARNING

Under South Carolina law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
